Loaves and Fishes Ministries was officially opened in April of 1982 to embody these words of Jesus, and has always taken this call very seriously.

However, the **REAL FACTS are incomplete without acknowledging that it is generous people like YOU who have kept our Emergency Shelter and our Transitional Homes going and growing.** If we have learned anything over these past many years, it is that we could never have even tried to meet the complex needs of homeless mothers, fathers, children, veterans and mentally ill without the generous support of our private and public donors.

The gratitude of our L&F guests is very REAL too! Monthly survey comments about "one thing they like best" include: *The respect I received from the staff and volunteers, feels like family, friendliness, helpful, great meals, cleanness, safe place, feels like home, the nicest volunteers, warm beds and hearts, the way they treated me is so uplifting, you show the love of Christ…and finally, I don't want to leave.*" In fact, we've learned that many homeless people regard L&F as the "Hilton of Shelters" in the Lansing area⁽⁾!!

But the stark REALITY is that our expenses continue to outpace declining public grants and private donations. We are continually facing rising costs for utilities, technology, repairs, maintenance, transportation, food, supplies and printing, plus paying our dedicated staff a livable wage – all of which are reflected in a budget shortfall of \$54,000 as of Oct 1, 2015.

So we once again come to you in all humility, asking you to remember L&F in your Holiday giving, and consider becoming a Sustaining Partner with us in feeding and sheltering those experiencing homelessness. In return you will be assured of our prayers and those of the guests who benefit from your generous and selfless gifts. May God abundantly bless you and your families during this Holiday Season!

From our Director: Jenny Leaf Spending Holidays Homeless

"Happy Holidays!" It is always amazing to me how these two words can conjure so many memories, warm feelings and anticipation of a wondrous time ahead. Many of us spend holidays gathering with

family and friends. We eat special meals and sweets until we are stuffed to the gills. We exchange gifts and good cheer. We celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ and then ring in the New Year with hopes of good things to come. We are truly blessed. Happy, indeed.

Many of our guests at Loaves and Fishes Ministries have the same kinds of memories from their pasts. They share those stories with us with twinkles in their eyes. Some get to spend time with family and friends sharing food and fellowship around the holidays while others no longer have, or never had, that in their lives. The difficulties and challenges that our guests face are monumental on any given day and sometimes that makes it really difficult to have a happy holiday season. For our brothers and sisters experiencing homelessness, survival does not allow taking a break to enjoy the warmth and glow of the season. Our guests still have to figure out transportation, look for jobs, make it to appointments, find enough to eat and stay warm...every single day. Sometimes this is even more difficult around the holidays as helping agencies close and transportation services stop in celebration of Christmas and New Year's Day.

It is our hope that Loaves and Fishes Ministries can make the night times a little bit brighter and warmer for our guests all year round, but especially during this time. We do everything we can to make our guests feel welcomed. While we cannot replace or make up for any lack of connection with loved ones, we do our best to let our quests know we care and value them. Our volunteers don't just serve meals, wash dishes and do a load of laundry (which isn't to say those things aren't important!). No, the most important time spent is visiting with the guests. They sit and talk during and after dinner to lend an ear and share laughter or sometimes tears. They share stories and make connections as human beings, not as housed and homeless. Because of this and all that our volunteers and donors provide, whether it's a tube of toothpaste, a warm coat, or a financial donation, our guests feel like guests. And maybe for a moment or two, the weight of being without a home of their own is lifted from their shoulders...and they, and we, realize that even though we might appear to be worlds apart, we are in fact the same.

What a wonderful way to celebrate the beauty of the season and honor the birth of Jesus Christ. I am truly blessed to be a part of this Ministry and to continue the work of Jesus along with all of you.


