

What a JOY for me to reflect on the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the founding of Loaves and Fishes Ministries, since I had the privilege of being one of the original five Core Group co-founders. It was late 1979 when we first started planning ALL that we would need to do to establish a shelter, secure a Special Use Permit to operate, and make certain it would be acceptable to the neighbors. We had numerous meetings - sometimes 2 or 3 consecutively on a single day - over several months to deal with all the intricacies. We finally found a house, thanks to Jim Booth, our realtor... *who then became an avid Wednesday overnight volunteer and served for years in that role till he sadly died in 2016.* Our hearts were inspired by the story of Jesus feeding the multitudes, and the Parable of the Last Judgement where the faithful ask Jesus, "Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry and gave you food, or thirsty and gave you something to drink? And when was it that we saw you a stranger and welcomed you, or naked and gave you clothing? And Jesus said to them, 'Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these, you did it to me.'" We were also led by our spiritual mentors: Mother Therese of Calcutta, Mahatma Gandhi, Dr. Martin Luther King, and were... *and still are,* guided by the nonviolence embraced by each of them. **Now, 40 years later, our hearts are overwhelmed with the goodness of all our dedicated staff, board members, and volunteers who served so lovingly over these many years. God bless them ALL. ♥♥♥**
