STEPPING STONES OVERVIEW

MISSION & VISION

The Mission of Stepping Stones Reentry Housing Program is to provide a safe, stable and supportive home and community in the first year of reentry, where Formerly Incarcerated Individuals are able to build a sustainable life through resources, connections, reentry, and wrap around services.

Our program is person centered, goal focused and trauma informed; each individual's story is different and we take the time to learn about them and their unique goals and needs in order to connect them to local resources and services that can best help them thrive. Instead of duplicating available services we build strong community connections and partnerships with local programs already doing the work.

MAY/JUNE OBJECTIVES

- Meet with RC that were referred to Program
- Begin our Goal Setting intake process with each potential candidate.
- Continue to meet weekly with RC and work on Goal Setting Intake.
- Interview "good fit" candidates with representatives from Loaves and Fishes, Power in Passion, and St Vincent DePaul.
- Choose first 3 residents for the program.
- Celebrate Grand Opening with Ribbon Cutting and Open House.
- Move in first 3 Residents
- Complete Resident Intakes
- Weekly Sunday Dinner and Fellowship coordinated by St Vincent DePaul
- Weekly House Meeting
- Weekly 1 on 1 Case Management Meetings
